16/88 The meeting was opened at 19:30 hours.

16/89 Notice of Meeting

Resolved: That Public Notice of the meeting had been given in accordance with Schedule 12 Para 10 (2) (b) of the Local Government Act 1972.

16/90 Apologies

Apology was received from Borough Cllr M Donohue-Moncrieff.

16/91 Declarations of Interest on Agenda Items

No declarations were made.

16/92 Police Report

A written report was circulated. Overall crime was down on the previous month. Two incidents of animals straying on the road were reported, Gypsies were in the area touting for business, and two road accidents at the junction of A1039 & A165 occurred at the end of May.

16/93 Public Comments

Comments were pasted about weeds being left uncut following the grass cutting. Following a question about disabled access following the fencing of the village green, it was confirmed that suitable provision would be made. Bushes alongside the Chain Path have been cut back. It was noted that the gate to the Wolds Way required repair and was to be reported to NYCC for action.

16/94 Report from County Councillor

The gullies were to be monitored to determine what further work was required. Councillors highlighted that complaints have been received that some gullies have not yet been cleaned out. The road markings on Badger Bends have been repainted and signage repair work was expected to be completed shortly. The lights on the roundabouts were to be replaced with LED lights.

16/95 Report from Borough Councillors

It was noted that the grid outside Rose Cottage was flooding after heavy rain. Cllr G Allanson confirmed that the street lights were owned by SBC, although NYCC were contracted to maintain them.

16/96 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

It was Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 11th May 2016 as circulated be approved and were signed by the Chair.

16/97 Matters Arising

(16/67) Following enquiries it was confirmed that the “CaP” meetings were administered by Filey Town Council, and they have agreed to notify Cllr G Barnett of the next meeting date when arranged.

(16/78) A letter has been written to Yorkshire Cost Homes about the caravan in Carr Lane, their response was awaited.

(16/80) It was noted that the pathway and gutters required cleaning by St. Marys Priory. A contractor was to be asked to undertake the work required.

(16/82) The Millennium Committee have agreed to pay for two extra grass cuts prior to the Scarecrow Festival.

16/98 Planning Applications

One planning application was received. 16/00997/HS application to extend the front and side elevations and creation of a balcony to first floor bedroom at, Bank Farm, Hunmanby Street, Muston. It was noted that a tree in the conservation area would require felling and it was felt that a replacement should be provided, otherwise there were no objections.

16/99 Village Issues

Village Green Fencing – The contractor has advised that the work will be completed before the end of July.

Kissing Gate by Church – Work on the replacement gate has now been completed.

2016 Garden Competition – A person has agreed to judge the competition and was to be escorted around the village by Cllr P Colling.

Pets R Wright – Two accidents have occurred at the junction at the end of May. Details were to be obtained to establish what happened.

Cleaning of War Memorial – A quotation of £1425 plus VAT has been received for cleaning and repairing the War Memorial. Potential funding sources were being investigated.

16/100 Finance

The schedule of payments for June was circulated prior to the meeting. It was Resolved that the figure totalling £1237.26 would be paid.

No reports were received.

16/102 Correspondence

Comments were received about the privet hedge at Muston Lodge being in need of cutting back. Cllr P Colling agreed to speak to the owner.
