16/123 The meeting was opened at 19:30 hours.

16/124 Notice of Meeting

Resolved: That Public Notice of the meeting had been given in accordance with Schedule 12 Para 10 (2) (b) of the Local Government Act 1972.

16/125 Apologies

Apology was received from Borough Cllr M Donohue-Moncrieff.

16/126 Declarations of Interest on Agenda Items

Cllr G Allanson declared an interest in one invoice submitted for payment.

16/127 Police Report

A written report was circulated.

16/128 Public Comments

A number of residents from Mount View expressed their concerns on the proposed plans for a new village hall. It was explained that whilst the parish council has given support to the village hall committee's funding application, it had not yet received any documentation relating to the planning application and was not in a position to comment. Councillors did however take note of the views expressed by residents.

16/129 Report from County Councillor

The Chevrons on the A165 have been be repainted. The sign post on the approach to Floatmanby Lane was badly rusted and required replacement.

16/130 Report from Borough Councillors

No issues were raised.

16/131 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

It was Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 13th July 2016 as circulated be approved and were signed by the Chair.

16/132 Matters Arising

(16/120) Cllrs D Walker and J Walker attend the Civic Service held by Hunmanby Parish Council on 24th July and provided feedback on the event.

16/133 Planning Applications

One planning application was received. 16/01618/FL application to erect a detached dwelling at, West House Farm, West Street, Muston. No objections were received.

16/134 Village Issues

2016 Garden Competition – Cllr P Colling was thanked for his hard work in organising this year's event. A discussion took place on how well it went to determine if anything could be improved next year.

Pets R Wright – No further progress has been made.

Cleaning of War Memorial – Three quotations have been received. Potential funding sources were being pursued before further progress could be made.

Speeding on Hunmanby Street – Following discussion it was agreed to make a three point approach to try to resolve the problem: to investigate how a local "Speeding Committee" could operate in order that offenders are reported to the Police, to have the 30mph sign on the approach to Muston moved further out, and to have a speed monitoring survey undertaken to determine the extent of the problem.

Village Pond – It was highlighted that the pond was becoming overgrown with weeds and also the trees required cutting back. Following discussion it was agreed to arrange for a contractor to cut back the vegetation, and that Cllr P Colling would organise the pruning back of the trees.

Sand Bags – A pallet of sand bags has been left at the junction of Hunmanby Street and West Street. It was agreed to move these into storage at Rakes Field.

16/135 Finance

The schedule of payments for September was circulated prior to the meeting. It was Resolved that the figure totalling £1974.38 would be paid.

Payments received: £247 from Southern Parish Cluster for the Kissing Gate, £272.28 from YLCA for the cost of operating the Website, and £500 from Millennium Committee for two additional grass cuts.

16/136 Reports

Cllr G Barnett reported that he had attended a meeting of Filey Safety Group which discussed their Safety Day results. It was decided not to continue it due to the cost.
