| 17/19 | <p>Notice of Meeting</p> <p>Resolved: That Public Notice of the meeting had been given in accordance with Schedule 12 Para 10 (2) (b) of the Local Government Act 1972.</p> |
| 17/20 | <p>Apologies</p> <p>Apologies were received from Cllr G Allanson, Cllr P Colling, and Borough Cllr M Donohue-Moncrieff.</p> |
| 17/21 | <p>Declarations of Interest on Agenda Items</p> <p>Cllr B Stevenson and Cllr G Barnett declared an interest in one item in 17/32.</p> |
| 17/22 | <p>Police Report</p> <p>A written report was circulated. There were no instances to report in the village. The Police have made changes to their incident reporting system with an improvement by the use of a “Community Messaging Service”.</p> |
| 17/23 | <p>Public Comments</p> <p>No issues were raised.</p> |
| 17/24 | <p>Report from County Councillor</p> <p>NYCC Cllr J Blackburn confirmed NYCC’s response concerning the Parish Council’s concerns about speeding on Hunmanby Street had been sent.</p> <p>NYCC were undertaken a consultation on Public Rights of Way with a view to reducing expenditure by the use of a prioritising system, with survey responses required by 19th March 2017.</p> <p>A councillor advised that a gully next to the Cross was full of leaves resulting in water running towards Round Lodge Corner.</p> |

17/25 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

It was Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 15th February 2017 as circulated be approved and were signed by the Chair.

17/26 Matters Arising

(17/08) Feedback about public concerns when trying to pay for brown bin collections at Filey Library was awaited.

(17/15) SBC were in discussion with the resident in West End about the street light attached to her property. Following discussion it was felt by councillors that a street light was required in this area and that if removed from the property a suitable alternative was required.

17/27 Planning Applications

No applications were received.

17/28 Local Government Boundary Changes

The Local Government Boundary Commission of England was undertaking a review of SBC area with a view to making some adjustments. Anyone wishing to make comments were advised contact the Boundary Commission via their website.

17/29 Village Issues

Cleaning of War Memorial – A decision on the funding application made to the War Memorials Trust was awaited.

Speeding on Hunmanby Street – NYCC have again given a negative response to the request to move the 30MPH limit sign further out. They have agreed to repaint the road markings but were not prepared to move the 30 MPH signs.

Village Pond – The Duck House was to be replaced on site shortly. The edge around the pond required tidying up.

Telephone Box – The process to adopt the telephone box will take several months to complete. Potential usages of the phone box were discussed including the possibility of installing a defibrillator. It was felt that further discussion was required before a decision could be made.

2017 Garden Competition – A discussion took place concerning the 2017 competition. Concerns were expressed about the overall lack of entries received and some councillors questioned if it was worth continuing with it. It was also suggested that if it did go ahead the number of categories should be reduced by the removal of "Hanging Baskets" given that only one entry has been received for the last two years. It was felt that a decision should be deferred until the next meeting to give time for further consideration.

17/30 Finance

The schedule of payments for March was circulated prior to the meeting. It was Resolved that the figure totalling £248.98 would be paid.

Payments received: NYCC (grant for tarmac at V Hall) £450

17/31 Reports

Cllr G Barnett advised that he would be attending a meeting of the Filey Safety Committee the following week.

17/32 Correspondence

Cllrs B Stevenson and G Barnett both declared an interest in this item and abstained from the discussion. A letter was received from Muston in Bloom concerning rats in the area around the village pond. It was agreed that options would be investigated to overcome the problem.

An estimate was received from the grass cutting contractor for the 2017 season at £250 + VAT per cut based on eight cuts during the season. It was agreed that the Millennium Committee were to be contacted to determine if they were willing to fund two cuts as in previous years.

It was agreed to hold the next meeting (including the Annual Parish Meeting) on 12th April 2017 starting at 1930 hours.
