17/69 Annual Governance Statement

The Annual Governance Statement was reviewed, approved by all and signed by the Chair.

17/70 Annual Accounts for 2016/17

The annual accounts were presented by the clerk, and following review were approved by all and signed by the chair.

17/71 Asset Register

The asset register was reviewed. It was noted that the ownership of the street lights has passed to SBC and should therefore be removed from the list of assets. With this amendment the Asset Register was approved by all.

17/74 Public Comments

Complaints were made about the rubbish being left behind by the bin men and not being cleaned up afterwards by anyone. It was highlighted that members of the Bloom Group collected litter, as did members from other groups in the village.

It was noted that weeds are growing in the footpaths around the village and it was agreed that a contractor would be employed to spray them.

17/76 Report from County Councillor

Due to the recent County Council elections the new County Councillor was not in attendance.

17/77 Report from Borough Councillors

17/78 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

It was Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 12th April 2017 as circulated be approved and were signed by the Chair.

17/79 Matters Arising

17/80 Planning Applications

Two applications were received.

Site Application No. 101/056 at The Hights, notification received that permission has been refused.

17/00778/FL application to erect a stable block at, Wood Cottage, Scarborough Road, Muston. No objections were received.

17/81 Village Issues

Cleaning of War Memorial –A decision on the funding application as still awaited from the War Memorials Trust.

Speeding on Hunmanby Street – NYCC have ignored requests to meet on site to discuss concerns about speeding, and also for the request for an advanced sign to highlight the approach to a 30MPH area should be erected 100 meters in advance of the existing signs. It was agreed to take this matter up with the new County Councillor.

Telephone Box – A decision was still awaited from British Telecom on the adoption of the telephone box. The current condition of the box was discussed and it was agreed to hold a site meeting to determine what work was required before proceeding further.

Light in West End – Confirmation on the alternative location for the replacement light was awaited from SBC.

Trees on Village Green – two planning applications have been submitted to SBC, one for “Crown Lifting” a Chestnut Tree with low branches, and the second for permission to cut down the other Chestnut Tree which was diseased. One quote for the required work has been received with other quotes awaited.

17/82 Finance

The schedule of payments for May was circulated prior to the meeting. It was Resolved that the figure totalling £1190.78 would be paid.

Payments received: 1st Instalment of Precept £3350, 1st Instalment of Model Agreement £1413.17 and VAT Refund £779.30.

An email was received from the Millennium Committee offering to pay for two cuts. They also enquired if we wished them to fund an additional tow cuts. Councillors wished to thank them and except their offer of funding a total of four cuts.
