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| 17/87 | The meeting was opened at 19:30 hours. The chair welcomed NYCC Cllr R Swiers to the meeting. |
| 17/88 | <p>Notice of Meeting</p> <p>Resolved: That Public Notice of the meeting had been given in accordance with Schedule 12 Para 10 (2) (b) of the Local Government Act 1972.</p> |
| 17/89 | <p>Apologies</p> <p>Apology was received from Borough Cllr M Donohue-Moncrieff.</p> |
| 17/90 | <p>Declarations of Interest</p> <p>No declarations were received.</p> |
| 17/91 | <p>Public Comments</p> <p>A number of residents in West End made comments relating to the position of a replacement street light. Various objections were raised on potential locations with no clear consensus emerging that everyone agreed with. It was highlighted by councillors that NYCC would decide on what they felt the best location should be, although the Parish Council insisted on being consulted in order to establish residents views before any work takes place.</p> <p>One resident felt that the verges in West End required tidying up, and another commented on the untidy verge on one side of Carr Lane.</p> <p>A resident commented on the number of accidents on the A165 with vehicles going into the hedge at the side of the road.</p> <p>Mr C Day was thanked for clearing the footpath leading from the church.</p> |
| 17/92 | <p>Police Report</p> <p>A written report was received from the Police.</p> |
| 17/93 | <p>Report from County Councillor</p> <p>County Cllr R Swiers introduced herself. She commented that she had noted the various issues of concern around the village and had arranged for three officers from NYCC to meet her in Muston the following week to see what can be done to move</p> |

matters forward.

17/94 Report from Borough Councillors

Cllr G Allanson advised that due to his recent illness he had very little to report. He was to attend a meeting of the Drainage Board. He highlighted that the Boundary Commission was undertaking a public consultation with residents within the area on the possibility of reducing the number Scarborough Borough Councillors to 45.

17/95 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

It was Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 10th May 2017 as circulated be approved and were signed by the Chair.

17/96 Matters Arising

(17/67) Cllr G Allanson confirmed that he was happy to represent the parish council at the Southern Parish Cluster meetings.

17/97 Planning Applications

Four applications were received.

17/00884/TCA approval given to crown lift a Chestnut tree on the Village Green.

17/00923/TCA approval given to fell one diseased Chestnut tree on the Village Green.

17/01032/FLA application to vary condition 1 relating to application 08/01095/FL dated 15/09/2008 for change of use of redundant foldyard outbuildings to form 3 holiday letting units at, Magdalen Grange Farm, Carr Lane, Gristhorpe. It was understood that one cottage was permanently occupied and it was believed that a second one also had a permanent occupant. Following discussion it was agreed to raise an objection to this application.

17/01235/HS application to erect a single storey rear and side extension at, 1 Cooks Row, Muston. It was believed that there was a right of way for near neighbours to gain access to the rear of their properties and it was felt that the planning department should consult with neighbours for their views. It was also highlighted that the brickwork for the extensions should match those of the existing building.

17/98 Village Issues

Cleaning of War Memorial – A grant has been offered for 75% of the total up to a maximum of £1160. A grant of £300 has also been received from the Southern Parish Cluster, leaving a shortfall of £300. Following discussion it was proposed by Cllr K Cole, seconded by Cllr G Allanson, to fund the difference and to proceed with the work, which was agreed.

Speeding on Hunmanby Street – A “Speed Concern Report” has been submitted to the Police, and a survey was to be arranged to determine the extent of the problem. It was noted that NYCC Cllr R Swiers was attempting to move matters forward.

Telephone Box – The telephone box has now been formally adopted by the parish council. It was noted that it required refurbishing and quotations were to be obtained to determine the cost.

The results of the survey were reviewed and the responses indicated that residents wished to have a Defibrillator installed in the telephone box. It was noted that a grant may be available towards the cost and also that certain local organisations have indicated that they may contribute towards the cost. Following discussion it was

agreed to make a funding application to the British Heart Foundation.

Cllr G Allanson advised that he had been approached by a resident following the survey who suggested that First Aid courses should be held. Following discussion it was generally felt that this was a good idea.

Light in West End – Residents views were taken on board. A decision was awaited from NYCC on whether or not they will be providing a replacement light.

Trees on Village Green – Planning permission has been received as set out in 17/97. It was also noted that on another tree some of the branches had fallen off and in need of clearing up, some of which had fallen onto adjacent land. A quote has been received for dealing with the three trees of £550. It was agreed to proceed with the work. The owner of the adjacent field was to be approached to determine if he wished the debris to be removed from his property.

17/99 Finance

The schedule of payments for May was circulated prior to the meeting. It was Resolved that the figure totalling £1863.07 would be paid.

Payments received: YLCA (Website Operating Costs) £402.62, and Muston Millennium Committee (for Grass cutting) £600.

It was noted that the bus shelter required repainting, and following discussion it was agreed to obtain a quotation.

17/100 Reports

Cllr G Barnett attended a meeting of the YLCA and highlighted the areas that were discussed, including that all communications should be via the clerk.

17/101 Correspondence

An invitation was received from Hunmanby Parish Council inviting the Chair to attend their Annual Parish Civic Service on 23th July. The Chair agreed to represent the parish council.

Notice of YLCA Joint Annual Meeting on 15th July 20217 was received.

Notice of NYCC Local Area Committee Meeting on 5th July 2017 was received.
