Cleaning of War Memorial – Cleaning work was expected to start shortly after 14th August 2017. Consideration was to be given to suitable publicity at the next meeting.

Speeding on Hunmanby Street – Feedback from NYCC as awaited.

Telephone Box – Quotations for repainting were awaited to determine the cost. It was agreed that it would be cleaned out before the start of the Scarecrow Festival.

A grant award has been obtained from The British Heart Foundation, who will supply the equipment, however they wish to have a donation of £600 towards the cost. Following discussion this was agreed. It was noted that some local organisations have indicated that they may make a contribution towards the cost. The cost of electricity used was expected to be in the region of £3 to £5 per year.

Light in West End – A discussion took place on what was the best location for the replacement light, with due regard to the views expressed by residents in West End. After careful consideration it was agreed that the best location was to the east of the old location on the other side of the track.

Trees on Village Green – The diseased Chestnut Tree and the rotten Oak Tree have both been cut down, together with the crown lift of other Chestnut Tree.
