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Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 10th April 2019

Notice of meeting: 19/169

Resolved: That Public Notice of the meeting had been given in accordance with schedule 12 Para 10 (2) b of the Local Government Act 1972.

Apologies: Councillor P Colling. 19/170

A letter was read out from Cllr. Colling announcing his decision to resign as a Parish Councillor at the next election. He stated that he enjoyed the time as a Parish Councillor and wished everyone well in the future.

Declarations of Interest on Agenda Items: 19/171

Cllr. Barnett declared interest on King Hill footpath.

Public Forum: 19/172

Residents expressed continued concern related to King Hill footpath & parking on the verge / roadside. **Resolved:** An item later in the agenda and any updates would be reported.

Resident expressed dissatisfaction that the defibrillator had not been installed & that alternative contractors should have been appointed. **Resolved:** AN agenda item & updates reported.

The state of grass at King Hill / A165 is in a poor state after work undertaken by Yorkshire Water. **Resolved:** Clerk will contact Yorkshire Water requesting improvement to the area they have disturbed.

Reports: 19/173

Police: Police report circulated prior to meeting. One traffic complaint received, one male arrested for cannabis use. No other incidents.

County Cllr Swiers: VAS signs can now be purchased at a cost of £2300-£2500, contributions can be made from the Locality Budget. Disabled Parking Spaces still being explored near Evron Centre, conflicting opinions on what is wanted. Park & Ride issues is out to consultation & an agenda item at the next CC meeting.

Borough Cllr. Allanson: Scrutiny & Health Committee looking at concerns related to hospital changes. Chevron signs need rectifying in Muston.

Cllr. Barnett – Community Police Group: 19/174

Attended recent local meeting. Speeding issues related to Muston Road / Filey Road area at specific times. No resolution.

Planning:

The Clerk has not been notified or made aware of any Planning Applications in the area. Cllr. Cole has received representation from a local resident near a proposed site to erect detached houses which are on the borders of Muston / Grinstead. Clerk made enquiries & that it was in Grinstead Parish. Councillors stated this is not so. Clerk & Cllr. Allanson will contact Planning to clarify.

Election:

All prospective candidate will be contacted by the Election Office on all related matter, meetings, dates etc. Clerk will be at the count.

Village Issues:

19/179

Defibrillator – Will be installed 15th April, the earliest possible date available. Training explored from NHS, there would be a cost of £240 to do this. A publicity / awareness event required in the village but decision on format deferred until new Council in place.

King Hill Footpath (This part of the meeting chaired by Cllr. Stevenson)

19/180

Continued concern over the safety aspects of the footpath for pedestrians. Ownership of land still being explored with NYCC legal department, has once again been raised with Highways staff. Request for exploration of a footpath on the opposite side of the road could be explored.

Correspondence:

- Clerk notified had been in touch with insurance company & kiosk & defibrillator are not included on current policy. Request for adjustment to be made accordingly.
- Grass contractor will be undertaking first cut in April. Clerk will contact to request meeting with Cllr. Stevenson.

Items for Next Agenda:

Clerk raised the point that the next meeting would be the AGM. This would also be the first meeting of the new Council requiring the appointment of officers as well as a great deal of administration tasks which would likely be time consuming. Declarations of interest, GDPR, Standing Orders, Codes of Conduct, Appointment of Officers all will be required to be covered.
